This incredible team made it possible to respond in a huge way to the major earthquake in Haiti in August. This earthquake was centered very close to all our operations in Haiti. Co-founder, Ken DeYoung and Board member, Conwell Larson, had a mission team in Haiti at the time of the earthquake, which allowed them to help in the immediate disaster response. Ken was able to fly our plane to Florida to load up emergency medical supplies and bring them back for our medical teams as they searched for people needing medical attention. These medical teams are still responding to remote areas of Haiti where there is no medical care. We had medical teams carrying supplies well into the mountains where no other organizations were going. Hope was delivered to many people.

In December, major tornados struck Kentucky. Our disaster relief team was onsite shortly after to begin assisting with disaster recovery efforts. This includes the physical needs, and, more importantly, the spiritual needs of the people we served. This was a several-month operation as the devastation was immense and widespread. Many thanks to Domestic Team Director, Dennis Anderson, and his team for delivering hope.

We are so thankful for all of our prayer warriors. We are constantly reminded of the power of prayer when we consistently witness God do things that don't seem possible. We thank our donors who responded with their financial support throughout the year resulting in record revenue being generously and graciously given.

We look forward to 2022 as we start the next decade of sharing God's love and delivering hope. Thanks to everyone for joining us and working alongside GoServ Global to accomplish His will.



YOUR IMPACT THROUGH STORY

On August 14th, 2021, our co-founder Ken DeYoung was sitting on a secondstory deck in Les Cayes, Haiti, enjoying his morning coffee while planning his day when his life, and many others in Haiti, were struck by a shocking force of nature - an earthquake. In 45 seconds, lives were ended, and those that were not, were forever changed. In the midst of destruction and utter chaos, Ken and the mission team jumped directly into action. In Land Cruisers still rocking from the action, the team headed directly for the epicenter with "fear and trembling," wondering what they would find.

Some houses stood, but many had fallen to rubble. Outside, people stood, some injured, some desperately searching beneath the debris for those who had been caught beneath it, and some too terrified to go back inside. Ken recalls, "Once the earthquake was over, it wasn't over" as the unnerving tremors kept coming. Destruction and brokenness surrounded them. It was an event that will have effects far beyond the day it happened, affecting life for years to come, as houses in Haiti take generations to build. They were looking at the shambles of years of investment and hard work for many families. That day the team raced to Eddy's house, where they helped establish a medical triage center in a steel Sukup building and brought the kids who had been physically injured at Bethel orphanage to the medical clinic. Eddy is our Country Director in Haiti. Miraculously, everyone at both locations survived. The team breathed a sigh of relief, but on the drive back, they witnessed the horrors of innocent people trapped beneath their own houses. The community was desperately in need of life-saving equipment and medical supplies.

The next day, Ken flew his plane to Fort Lauderdale, Florida, to get urgent medical supplies, but it would not be nearly enough. The situation was massive and desperate. Supplies from many organizations and resources rushed in for two days before all but one helicopter abandoned the island. Frustrated and knowing that people in remote areas were trapped, injured, and had no access to medical supplies, Ken and our team began brainstorming. They needed to send medical teams into the mountains. Not caring that it might leave them with nothing, the team donated their Land Cruisers to the cause and did whatever was necessary to reach the injured.

YOUR IMPACT THROUGH STORY

Physical injuries were not the only trials affecting those they met, but the people had emotional and spiritual needs. So, with the medical team, we sent members of our own teams from local churches to share the good news of the Gospel. Every day for six weeks these teams went out, and after those six weeks they continued to do one or two trips a week before the teams ran out of money and could no longer go up regularly. Where the Land Cruisers couldn't venture, donkeys were used to carry supplies well into the mountains. The plane, which Ken used to get some initial emergency supplies from Florida, is funded by generous donors of GoServ Global (GSG). When they were led by God's direction to jump immediately into action, they were able to provide care using resources and financial donations. The team had the ability to send medical and missionary teams to the mountains - bringing hope for God's people physically, spiritually, and emotionally. The work will never be completely done, and, as Ken says, "You can't do it all. The most important thing for me is to try to be in touch with the Holy Spirit to lead us in the right direction in where to say 'yes' and where to say 'no' and to have the discernment to do that." Through the power of the Holy Spirit, Ken and our team stepped up immediately after the earthquake to provide care to those in need. Those in Haiti felt and responded to your giving. Eddy, our Haitian Director, extends his thanks, saying, "I have the honor and the privilege to present my gratitude to all GSG donors, friends, and family for supporting Haiti in many ways. I want to take this moment to thank you so much for helping GSG to respond to the different crises that have happened to Haiti over the last year. Thank you for your compassion, thank you for your love and generosity to GSG toward those who have been impacted by the recent terrible earthquake that hit Haiti. Thanks to you, GSG was able to provide hope to dozens of vulnerable people who have been adversely affected by the earthquake. Your donation allowed GSG to feed the hungry people in very needy areas, to provide shelters to those families who lost their homes. Thank you. Your donation has allowed GSG to take care of dozens of patients to be treated through the medical clinics and in the mountains of Haiti. Together, with GSG, you made hope possible in Haiti when all seemed dark and desperate. For all you do, thank you so much. May God continue to bless you, watch over your ministry, watch over your family, and your business. Thank you so much."
