A MESSAGE FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

By God's grace, 2022 was another fantastic year for GoServ Global. With your support, and together with our wonderful staff, Board of Directors, Country Directors, volunteers, ambassadors, and our field staff, we continue to see lives and communities transformed by Jesus. We are very thankful that you are walking with us on this remarkable journey as we spread the gospel wherever God leads us.

It is so good to have the pandemic behind us as things are returning to normal. There were no mission trips in 2021, but we had 4 trips in 2022. Three of those were international and one was here in the United States with our Domestic team. We were able to have our annual banquet this year after having to cancel it in 2021.

At the core of everything we do is our mission to "share God 's love by responding to disasters, empowering sustainable community development and creating world change through hands-on involvement." Our tagline of "Delivering Hope" is played out daily as we can provide basic human needs, education and shelter to vulnerable and poverty-stricken children and adults, along with meeting their spiritual needs.

As you read through this annual report, I would like to share some of the 2022 high-lights below:

- New staff was hired including Regan Steffen, Mark Doss, and Tiffany Thumma
- Kentucky tornado cleanup from a series of tornados including an EF4 continued from the Dec 2021 tornado into the end of February of 2022
- Winterset, IA EF4 tornado in March 2022, with clean up beginning right after the Kentucky cleanup
- Peruvian Pastor Garcia's double knee replacement surgery here in the United States
- 500th Safe T Home in Haiti
- 1000th baby born at the Haiti birthing center
- Terry Baxter conducted a pastor's conference in Haiti that saw 500 people attend
- Terry Baxter led a pastor's conference in Uganda
- We purchased the 10 Safe T Home® units to send to Liberia next year
- Genesis Church in Peru fundraised \$1M for their building to be purchased in January of 2023
- We hosted a highly successful RAGBRAI Oasis outreach event
- We received our first \$1M donation
- We began working with an outside consultant to help us prepare for the next 10 years of growth

Financially, God touched the hearts of our wonderful donors as our revenues were up 52% from 2021 resulting in a record revenue of over \$5M. This has helped to ensure the financial sustainability of GoServ Global, build a reserve fund, and provide a way to fund new projects that God will ask us to do in 2023. Every dollar invested in GoServ Global helps to build God's Kingdom. Thank you for your financial and prayer support throughout 2022 and for all those who volunteered.

I expect 2023 to be another exciting year as we seek God's will to make a difference in people's lives. Thanks for serving alongside GoServ Global. To God be the glory!

UGANDA




